Students took their first Vocabulary Test this week. We will begin our spelling unit 1. These words are made up of our 12 vocabulary words and math vocabulary terms from Chapter 1. Spelling Contract and Test is Wednesday.

We recorded our second Reading Minutes on Monday. Students continue to read weekly and complete their log assignments. In class, we have been studying the concept of Compare and Contrast. We even had some practice on Study Island!
